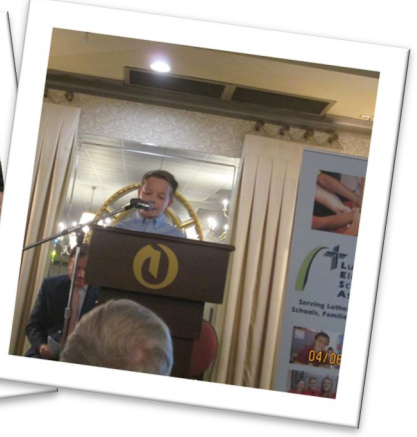
The 4th quarter offering will go to support the Guatemala mission work and is being matched dollar-for-dollar up to \$500.
